CATEGORIES OF IMPROVEMENT

- Public Art (i.e. murals, sculptures)
- Landscape Enhancements
- Wayfinding & Signage
- Façade Improvements (improvements to the front or exterior of a building)
- Transit-Oriented / Streetscape Improvements
- Other (doesn't fit neatly into a category but fits other eligibility requirements and aligns with the spirit of the grant)



ELIGIBLE LOCATIONS

- Located in City of Columbus corporation limits, preferably in opportunity neighborhoods (see website for details)
- In publicly accessible locations that accommodate a variety of users



IDEA > IMPLEMENTATION

Project ideas AND implementation must be community driven, meaning:

- Entrants must be teams of residents and/or organizations
- Volunteers must come from the community
- Where possible, get community feedback on themes, ideas, or activities!



PROJECT FUNDING

- Grants of up to \$15,000* will be awarded to selected proposals
- Entrants are encouraged to have matching funds to maximize project impact

**Proposals may be granted less than requested at the discretion of the jury*
