- Located in City of Columbus corporation limits, preferably in opportunity neighborhoods (see website for details)
- In publicly accessible locations that accommodate a variety of users



## IDEA > IMPLEMENTATION

Project ideas AND implementation must be community driven, meaning:

- Entrants must be teams of residents and/or organizations
- Volunteers must come from the community
- Where possible, get community feedback on themes, ideas, or activities!



## PROJECT FUNDING

- Grants of up to \$15,000\* will be awarded to selected proposals
- Entrants are encouraged to have matching funds to maximize project impact

*\*Proposals may be granted less than requested at the discretion of the jury*
